In order to accept this invitation, you must be able to participate in the entire two weeks of the program and speak English at a conversation level.

The **objective** of Chaplains Interaction is to provide professional training to further prepare chaplains, or people who hope to minister in a chaplain's role, in their role of directing the command religious program in their unit. Participants will discuss how to be more effective as part of their unit or base and how to relate with and support their commanding officers. The program provides extensive round table discussions to allow for an exchange of ideas and information, as well as Christian fellowship. It is our prayer that you will be greatly encouraged in your military profession as a chaplain, and be more effective in helping to support your local Military Christian Fellowship.

You should request funding for your travel expenses from your government; ACCTS has some limited scholarship funding available on request. If you are accepted as a participant, we will pay for your expenses while in the program. You may need to pay local departure taxes and visa fees, and you will be responsible for any personal expenses while in attendance.
