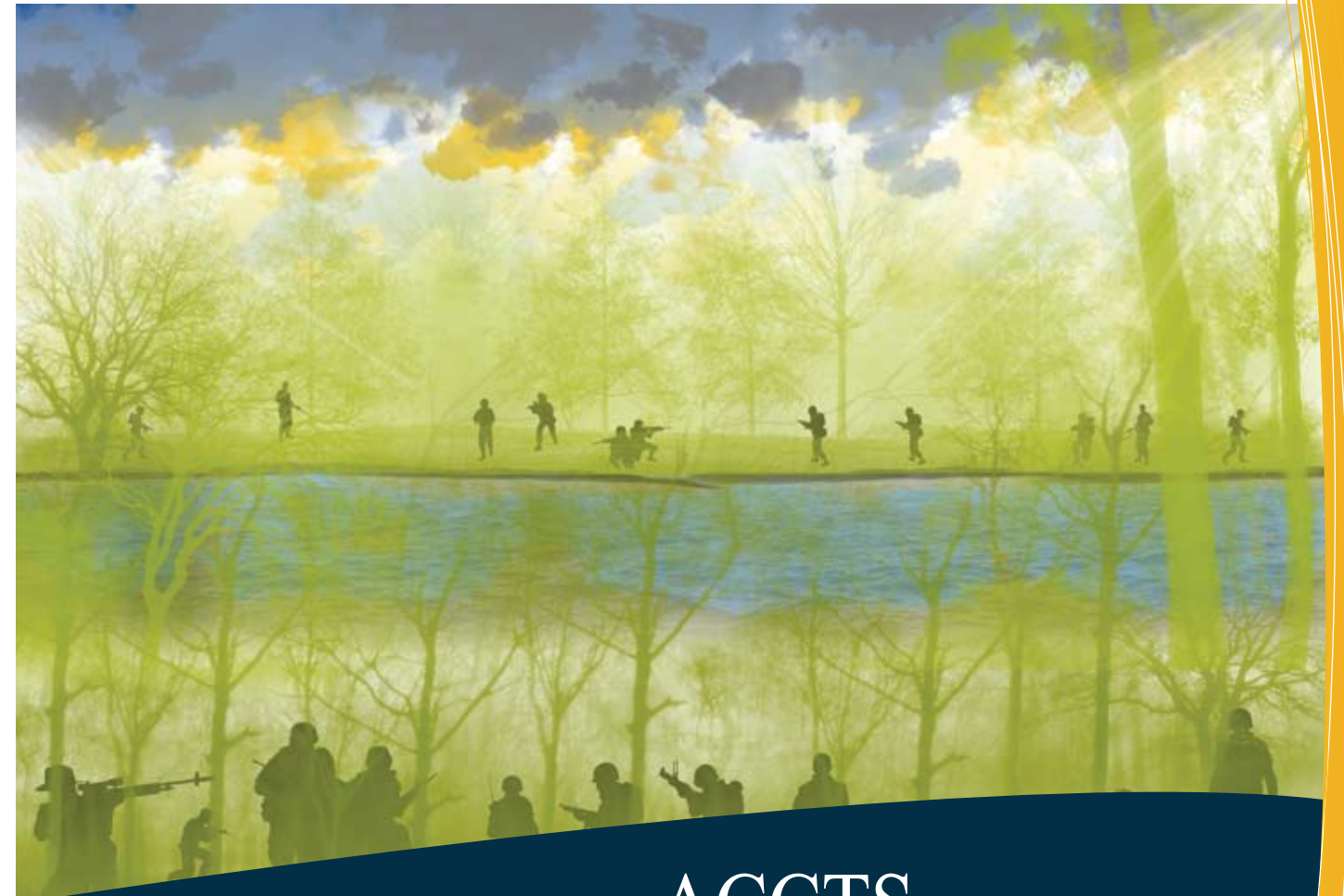

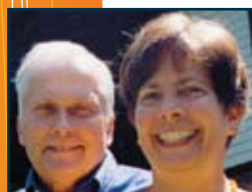

LTC (USA, RET.) DICK AND LINDA BARNES

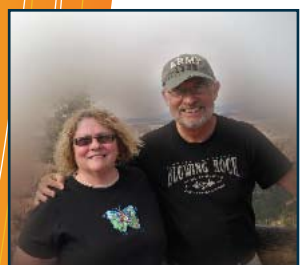

LTCOL (AUSTRALIAN ARMY, RET.) RUSSELL AND HELEN BIELENBERG

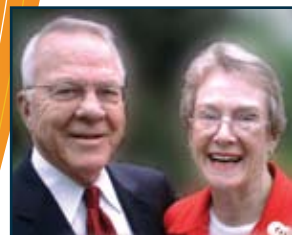

European Ministry

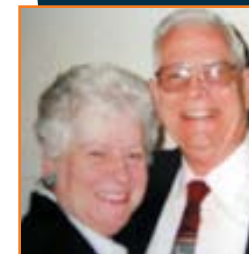
COL (USA, RET.) EARL AND SUE CASNER

LTC (USA, RET.) BOB AND BILLIE JEAN (B.J.) REIFSNYDER

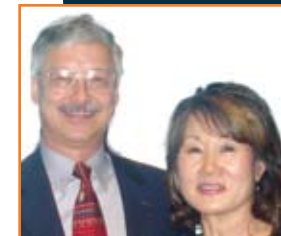

CHAPLAIN LT COL (USAF, RET.) ROB AND DELORES STROUD

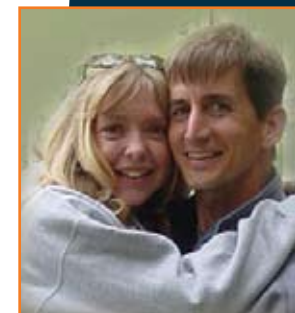

LT COL (USAF, RET.) PAUL AND SUZY NEU

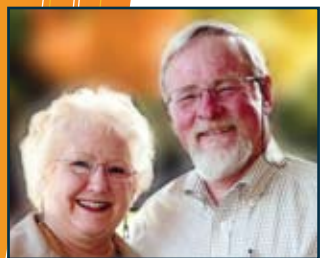
Paul directs and organizes ACCTS' American English Language Training programs, which are held in conjunction with military Christian fellowships who host them as a way to both teach English and share Christ.

LTCOL (BRITISH ARMY, RET.) NOEL AND MERYL DAWES

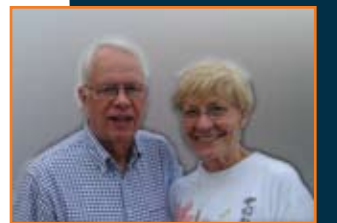

LT COL (USAF, RET.) JIM AND LOIS GRESHEL

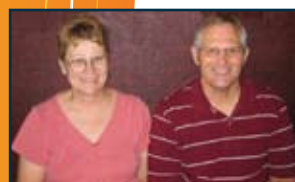

CDR (CHAP, USN, RET.) DON AND ELAINE JUKAM

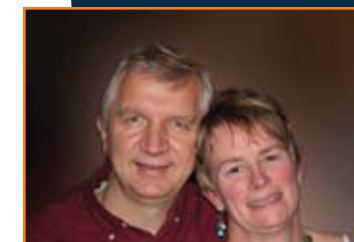
Don and Elaine Jukam participate in ACCTS ministries relating to chaplains ministry and outreach while Don also pastors a church in Washington.

MICHAEL AND JOYCE KNEFLEY

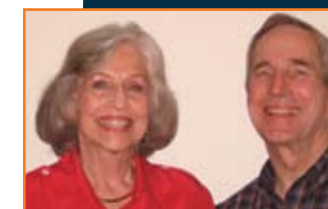

COL (USA, RET.) BILL AND SUZANNE LUMPKIN

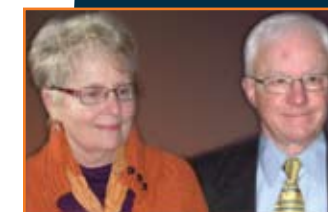
