

Ministry Opportunity:

DIRECTOR OF CHAPLAIN SUPPORT MINISTRIES

ACCTS has a staff position available for a former military chaplain who has a heart for ministering around the world to chaplains in other countries' militaries. The Director of Chaplain Support:

- develops and plans ACCTS' chaplain ministries, including international chaplain training programs
- creates and sustains supportive and encouraging relationships with international military chaplains, sharing ministry tools with them
- directs ACCTS staff activities that support chaplains

This is an unpaid position, so the Director of Chaplain Support will need to raise support for ministry expenses (although the position requires more time than funding). Relocation isn't needed, as most ACCTS staff work out of their homes.
